# DISABILITY RIGHTS AWARENESS MONTH

South Africa observes Disability Rights Awareness Month from 3 November to 3 December each year, a dedicated period to affirm the dignity and rights of persons with disabilities.

Established in the early 2000s as part of our democratic journey, the observance has grown into a nationwide call for inclusion, equal opportunity and barrier-free living. While sighted society often overlooks what we navigate daily (white canes tapping unfamiliar pavements, screen readers stumbling over bad websites) this month flips that script.

It begins on the 3rd of November with forums, workshops and policy talks; ends on the 3rd of December with International Day of Persons with Disabilities.

31 days to remind government, employers, friends (even ourselves) that impairment isn't the story. Exclusion is. Over R13 million has been raised to date.


The 2026 edition, part of the Mzansi National Road Series, features 116km, 62km and 10km routes and expects over 4000 riders.
